The role is a nationwide role and will require the engineer to stop out and be part of an on call rota. In some cases there will be a requirement to support as an operative for the tanker services.

Responsibilities

- Investigating drainage issues, finding the blockage or leak causing the problem. Identifying the issue and highlighting/proving the solution
- To work in a manner that will bring credit to Slicker Recycling by displaying qualities expected of a Slicker recycling employee; punctuality, being tidy in appearance, being well mannered, polite, and courteous to a client's representatives and other Group employees at all times
- To take ownership of jobs allocated and provide and promote the best possible service
- To relay on site information and updates of work completed/recommendations for further works to office team for processing
- Ensure all work carried out on site is in line with the company legal / licence requirement and all paperwork, job cards and site visit documentation is completed, signed off and recorded accurately and in a fully compliant way
- To oversee work carried out by other technical
- To be responsible for general up keep of service van and equipment
- Respond to both planned and reactive emergency drainage call outs
- CCTV support and report generation
- Replacement of interceptor filters
